Re: COVID-19 Foregone Revenue Rate Rider Model Application, Halton Hills Hydro Inc., Board File no. EB-2019-0039

Halton Hills Hydro Inc. ("HHHI") has filed its COVID-19 Foregone Revenue Rate Rider Model Application with the Ontario Energy Board ("the Board"). Please note that the model indicates HHHI is requesting an effective date of August 1, 2020 to January 31, 2021 for the implementation of the proposed Foregone Revenue Rate Riders. However, HHHI is in fact requesting a <u>six (6) month recovery from</u> <u>November 1, 2020 to April 30, 2021</u>. HHHI was unable to adjust the model to reflect the correct recovery period and was not able to have the model revised before the filing deadline.
