Re: EB-2018-0263: EPCOR Natural Gas Limited Partnership ("ENGLP") – Southern Bruce Project Leave to Construct Application

Pursuant to Schedule-B Conditions of Approval, Section 2(b)(iv) of the Decision and Order dated July 19, 2020 in this proceeding, ENGLP must provide written notice of the project in-service date no later than 10 days after the facilities go into service.

On review of this matter, ENGLP has determined that notice was not filed with the Board within the abovenoted timeline. This oversight came about during a period of construction delays and staff transition in respect of personnel providing regulatory supports.
