**DECISION AND ORDER**

Ameresco JPII Carbon Reduction Inc. (Ameresco JPII) filed a complete application on August 26, 2020 under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) for an electricity storage licence.

Ameresco JPII was formed in 2019 to own and operate the 1.1 MW Ameresco JP-II Carbon Reduction battery storage facility, located in London, Ontario.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority, pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

After considering the application and assessing technical capability and financial viability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue the electricity storage licence to Ameresco JPII Carbon Reduction Inc.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The application is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
