**Application for an Electricity Retailer Licence & an Electricity

DECISION AND ORDER

Duke Energy Services Canada ULC (DESC) filed two application on July 13, 2020, with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) pursuant to section 60 of the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998 (OEB Act), for an electricity retailer licence and an electricity generation licence.

The OEB combined the applications into one proceeding, pursuant to section 21(5) of the OEB Act. This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority without a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

DESC will own and operator two 4 MW natural gas generator units that will provide onsite generation to Linamar Corporation, an industrial complex, under a large volume retail contract.

After considering the technical and financial capability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue an electricity generation licence and an electricity retailer licence to DESC.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application for an electricity retailer licence is granted on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
2. The application for an electricity generation licence is granted on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
