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Hydro One states "As summarized in the Hydro One Networks' 2018-2022 Distribution Rate Application – Distribution Productivity Report ("Productivity Report") for 2018 and 2019 years, Hydro One was able to achieve additional \$4.5 million in productivity savings in 2018 and an additional \$25 million in productivity savings in 2019 relative to the forecast filed in the application. Hydro One is committed to adhering to the robust governance process which has been established for defining and monitoring savings across the organization."

Please provide a description of the drivers of all productivity savings in 2018 and 2019 compared to forecast and explain how the additional productivity savings were achieved and measured.

Hydro One states "In 2019, the achieved ROE was 1.9% higher than the deemed ROE of 9.0% owing to weather and achieved productivity reductions, offset in part by increased operations, maintenance, and administration expenses."
