Dear Zora Crnojacki,

I would like to share an update on the proposed Kirkwall-Hamilton natural gas pipeline project that is being undertaken by Enbridge Gas.

In May, Enbridge Gas asked the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) for a temporary pause in the regulatory review of this project to give us time to assess any potential impacts to the project as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic.

This temporary pause was granted by the OEB on May 19, 2020, with a requirement that Enbridge Gas report back on the project's status by November 19, 2020.

Via this letter I am informing you that, with the ongoing pandemic persisting for the foreseeable future, Enbridge Gas has determined that there is no longer a need for the project in the timeframe originally proposed. Therefore, Enbridge Gas has withdrawn its application to the OEB for leave to construct the Kirkwall-Hamilton pipeline project.

Enbridge Gas will review the project in 2021 and advise if conditions change and necessitate a new project application filing with the OEB.
