LETTER OF DIRECTION

Dear Mr. Denomy:

Re: Enbridge Gas Inc. (Enbridge Gas) NPS 20 Waterfront Relocation Leave to Construct Application Ontario Energy Board File Number EB-2020-0198

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) has now issued its Notice of Hearing for Enbridge Gas's **NPS 20 Waterfront Relocation Leave to Construct Application** (Notice). The English and French versions of the Notice will be published by the OEB, in accordance with directions to the OEB's media agent which were copied to you. Please note that you must comply with the directions in paragraphs 1 through 5 below **prior to November 20, 2020**, which is the publication date of the newspaper in which the Notice will appear last. If you are unable to comply with the directions within this timeframe, you must inform the Registrar immediately at <u>registrar@oeb.ca</u>.

You are directed:

- 1. To conduct a search of title forthwith, sufficient to determine the current registered property owners and encumbrancers with lands or interest in the lands directly affected by the proposed pipeline and related facilities.
- 2. No later than the date the Notice is posted on Enbridge Gas's website in accordance with paragraph 3, to arrange for the service of both the English and French versions of the enclosed Notice, in the exact forms accompanying this letter, and the application and the evidence, directly on each of the following:
 - all property owners and encumbrancers with lands or interest in lands identified in the search of title referred to in paragraph 1 above

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- b. the clerk of the City of Toronto
- c. Toronto Waterfront Revitalization Corporation (Waterfront Toronto)
- d. Toronto and Region Conservation Authority
- e. all Indigenous communities that have been consulted or with lands or interest in the lands directly affected by the proposed pipeline and related facilities
- f. the Métis Nations of Ontario, Suite 1100 66 Slater Street, Ottawa, ON K1P 5H1
- g. all affected utilities and railway companies
- h. members of the Ontario Pipeline Coordinating Committee

(Note: It is acceptable to serve the evidence by e-mail provided the party has stated its preference for the same.)

- 3. To make a copy of both the English and French versions of the Notice, the application and the evidence, and any amendments thereto, available for public review at Enbridge Gas's office and in a prominent place on Enbridge Gas's website.
- 4. To file with the OEB an affidavit proving completion of the matters in paragraphs 1 through 3 above immediately thereafter, with the Notices and original post office registration receipts, courier confirmation lists or e-mail delivery receipts (where applicable) attached.
- 5. To provide a copy of both the English and French versions of the Notice, the application and the evidence, and any amendments thereto, to anyone requesting the material.

You are further directed not to include any documents or materials when serving the Notice other than documents or materials expressly required by this letter of direction to be served.
