**Re: ENWIN Utilities Ltd.
2021 IRM Rate Application – Inflation Factor Election
EB-2020-0017**

On November 9, 2020, the Ontario Energy Board (“OEB”) issued a letter that established the process for the implementation of the inflation factor for use in 2021 rate adjustment applications. In the letter, the OEB noted it was allowing utilities the discretion of electing the calculated inflation factor per the OEB-approved methodology (offset by the applicable stretch factor and other adjustments for some plans) or a lower value.

In response to the OEB’s letter, ENWIN Utilities Ltd. (“ENWIN”) hereby confirms that it is electing the standard inflation factor as calculated by the OEB of 2.2% for purposes of its 2021 IRM Rate Application, which will be offset by ENWIN’s Group 3 stretch factor assignment of 0.3%, for a net Price-Cap IR adjustment of 1.9%.
