Further to the Ontario Energy Board's (OEB) acknowledgment letter dated November 2, 2020, the OEB has completed its preliminary review of your 2022 Incremental Capital Module application and will now commence the processing of your application. The next steps will be communicated in due course.

For administrative purposes, the OEB assigned a new docket number for this proceeding, EB-2020-0249. However, the OEB considers this amended application as a continuation of the EB-2018-0219 proceeding. The OEB finds that it is appropriate to combine the two proceedings and both docket numbers should be referenced in all filings and correspondence going forward.

The parties that were granted intervenor status and cost award eligibility in EB-2018-0219 are deemed to be intervenors and are eligible for cost awards in this proceeding.
