DECISION AND ORDER

Glencore Canada Corporation filed an application on October 16, 2020, with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) pursuant to sections 60 and 74 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act), for a renewal and amendment of its electricity wholesaler licence.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The application has been considered by the Delegated Authority without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

The amendment that Glencore is seeking is the addition of two trade names to Schedule 1 of its existing electricity wholesaler licence: the GECO Division located at Manitouwadge, Ontario and its Mattabi Division located at Ignace, Ontario. The request to add Glencore's two trade names arises from the IESO, who has informed Glencore that it has separately registered these locations and that they require that each location be separately identified in the licence. Glencore stated that there are no other changes requested to the licence.

The OEB having considered the application grants the renewal and the amendment to schedule 1 of licence EW-2015-0300. All other provisions remain the same.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
