NPS 20 Waterfront Relocation Project (Project)**

On November 20, 2020 Infrastructure Ontario (IO) sent an email to Enbridge Gas regarding the Project. The OEB was copied on the email. The email from IO indicated that property owned by the Minister of Government and Consumer Services is within and adjacent to the Project's study area. IO stated that if government property is required for the Project, then Enbridge Gas should contact IO so that it can advise about requirements for obtaining government property.

Subsequent to the email from IO, on November 25, 2020, Enbridge Gas received a letter from the OEB requesting that Enbridge Gas file a letter with the OEB that responds to the email from IO.

Enbridge Gas has reviewed the email from IO and the letter from the OEB and in this letter is providing its response.

The correspondence sent by IO is typical of the correspondence Enbridge Gas receives from interested parties during the course of the commencement of a facilities project. As part of its consultation process Enbridge Gas documents these communications in a consultation log and responds to any issues raised by interested parties. The consultation logs are filed within the Environmental Report within the leave to construct application. The consultation logs will typically document, the date of contact with Enbridge Gas by the interested party, the interested party who made contact, the type of contact used by the interested party (email, verbal conversation etc....), the concern or issued raised, the date of Enbridge Gas's response and Enbridge Gas's response and resolution (if applicable).

The email received from IO is typical of the type of correspondence received from IO when they are consulted with regarding a facilities application.

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Enbridge Gas has selected a running line for the Project and the entirety of the running line is within the Right of Way. At this time, Enbridge Gas has not identified a need to acquire provincial government lands. During development of the Project, should the government lands referenced by IO be required for the Project, Enbridge Gas will contact IO in order to determine the requirements for obtaining government property.
