London Line Replacement Project - Response to FRPO Request for Clarification

Enbridge Gas is writing in response to a letter filed by the Federation of Rental-housing Providers of Ontario (FRPO) with the Board. In its letter dated December 14, 2020, FRPO is requesting clarification with respect to the London Line Replacement Project. The clarification sought is whether the London Dominion Line still connects the Komoka Station to the Byron Station.

Enbridge Gas provides the following clarification:

- The London Lines are accurately described in the pre-filed evidence as running from Dawn to Komoka. The London lines between Komoka and Byron Transmission station were previously abandoned due to integrity concerns. This section of the pipeline was abandoned in phases and the final abandonment was completed in 2018.
- The description of the London Lines in the Engineering Asset Plan dated July 4, 2016, filed at Exhibit I.BOMA.5, Attachment 3, was written in 2016 before the completion of the abandonment of the section of the pipeline between Komoka and Byron station.
- Unfortunately, the London Lines were erroneously referenced as the lines between Dawn to Byron in the Asset Management Plan ("AMP") revised October 5, 2020 (revised) at page 106, filed at Exhibit I.ED.1, Attachment 1. Enbridge Gas notes that it will file a correction to the AMP in its 2021 rates application where the AMP is filed in support of its ICM request.
