RE: EB-2020-0192 – EGI London Lines Project - FRPO Request Outstanding

We are writing in response to EGI's reply of earlier today and seeking the outstanding response requested. While EGI has confirmed the conflicting evidence, our original request remains only partially answered. Further, the response does not reconcile with evidence provided.

In its letter of today, EGI states that the section of pipe between Komoka and Byron, was abandoned in stages with the final abandonment being completed in 2018. However, in the last Asset Management Plan dated November 2018¹, specifically speaks to a future replacement of the London Lines and that the section from Komoka to Byron was operating at a lower pressure of 1380kPa. This evidence reinforces the need to receive the information requested in our letter seeking confirmation of the existence of this section of pipe. With EGI's answer in the negative, we asked:

- b) If not, when were the respective Dominion and South Lines disconnected?
 - i) Why were the lines disconnected?
 - ii) Please provide the internal company reports, memos and authorizations that lead to the abandonments which disconnected the London Lines from Byron.

We would ask that the responses be provided to us and other interested parties and put on the record in this proceeding.
