Re: Canadian Niagara Power Inc. - EB-2020-0008 Application for 2021 Rates

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) issued a Decision and Rate Order in the above-noted proceeding on December 10, 2020. This Decision and Rate Order was accompanied by a Tariff of Rates and Charges (Schedule A), which the OEB stated would remain “draft” until after Canadian Niagara Power had an opportunity to review it for completeness and accuracy.

By letter filed on December 15, 2020, Canadian Niagara Power submits that upon having “reviewed the Tariff of Rates and Charges set out in Schedule A [Canadian Niagara Power] believes that a correction is required in respect of the LRAMVA rate rider of \$25.0829/kW for its Street Lighting rate class”. As part of the proceeding, Canadian Niagara Power identified that a rate rider of \$25.0829/kW, based on a 12-month disposition period, would result in total bill impact of 23.7%. In order to mitigate bill impacts, Canadian Niagara Power proposed a 48-month disposition period (for the portion of the LRAMVA claim allocated to its Street Lighting rate class only), reducing the rate rider to \$6.2707/kW. Canadian Niagara Power has requested that the OEB confirm whether its proposed mitigation proposal is accepted.

The OEB has considered the correspondence and finds that, due to an inadvertent omission error, the mitigation proposal was not addressed and, therefore, the correction is necessary. In accordance with the provisions of the Decision and Rate Order issued on December 10, 2020, and Rule 41.02 of the OEB’s *Rules of Practice and Procedure*, the OEB is reissuing the Decision and Rate Order to reflect the correction. The correction can be found in the LRAMVA section of the Decision and Rate Order, and is reflected in the LRAMVA rate rider charge related to the Street Lighting service classification in the accompanying Tariff of Rates and Charges (Schedule A).
