Re: **IESO 2021 Expenditure, Fees and Revenue Requirement
EB-2020-0230**

In response to your letter dated December 4, 2020, the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) confirms that the 2020 interim fee order issued by the OEB on December 17, 2019 will remain in effect after December 31, 2020 and will continue to remain in effect until final fees are approved by the OEB.¹ Accordingly, the Independent Electricity System Operator (IESO) must continue charging the fees approved in that order, on an interim basis; no further interim order is required for 2021. The OEB understands that the IESO will file an application for final fees once its 2020-22 business plan has been approved by the Minister of Energy, Northern Development and Mines. The file number EB-2020-0230 has been reserved for that application.
