**Preamble:**      Mr. Neme's evidence is that "IRP analyses are much more robust if they involve stakeholders in the key steps associated with the making of decisions rather than just as potential sources of information or in perfunctory discussions after decisions have largely been made" and that "the [Ontario Energy Board] and stakeholders should be informed and included throughout the IRP process."

Mr. Neme suggests that the IRP framework should establish a planning committee, modeled on Vermont's System Planning Committee, to secure input throughout the planning process from key stakeholders.

- a)      Please comment on the value of including Indigenous communities among the stakeholders involved in IRP analyses.
- b)      Please comment on whether Indigenous communities should be represented on any planning committee established in respect of the IRP framework.


