DECISION AND ORDER

Cytec Canada Inc. filed an application on September 18, 2020, with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) pursuant to section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act), for a renewal of its electricity wholesaler licence.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

The applicant was previously licensed by the OEB, however it did not renew its electricity wholesaler licence upon expiry December 21, 2015. It has been operating without a licence since December 22, 2015.

After considering the technical and financial capability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue the electricity wholesaler licence to Cytec Canada Inc. given its ongoing participation in the electricity wholesale markets are necessary to its operations. The granting of this is without prejudice to any future compliance actions regarding Cytec Canada Inc.'s operating without a licence.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
