**Re: Ontario Energy Board File No.: EB-2020-0265 - Intervention Request**

The Ottawa International Airport Authority (OIAA) is the operator of the Ottawa Macdonald-Cartier International Airport (the "Airport") on a long-term land lease from Transport Canada, and has been notified of the project by Hydro One Networks (HONI) for which application EB-2020-0265 has been made to the Ontario Energy Board (OEB).

As the entity responsible for the stewardship and safe operation of the Airport, OIAA ensures, in coordination with a number of other regulatory agencies including but not limited to Nav Canada, that any infrastructure or development project being carried out on Airport property complies with all applicable laws and regulations, in particular having to do with aircraft operational safety. OIAA also ensures at all times that it is aware of any impact on its overall facilities.

As such, we request intervenor status in the above referenced file, including the possibility of recovering costs.
