DECISION AND ORDER

AI 2191 Yonge Ltd. filed a complete application on December 22, 2020 with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB), under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) for an electricity retailer licence. The licence would allow the applicant to retail electricity to large volume consumers in Ontario.

The applicants will operate the CHP generation facility installed in multiunit residential building and will supply the building with electricity and heat generated in accordance with the terms of the Energy Service Agreement.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority, pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

After considering the application and assessing technical capability, financial viability and conduct of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue the electricity retailer (large volume) licence to AI 2191 Yonge Ltd.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application by AI 2191 Yonge Ltd. for an electricity retailer licence (large volume consumers only) is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
