DEFICIENCIES IN EGI IRP FRAMEWORK PROPOSALS

- Incomplete List of Guiding Principles
- Outstanding Questions on Need Determination
- Incomplete Presentation of Alternatives



INCOMPLETE LIST OF GUIDING PRINCIPLES

- Authors of IRP Framework for EGI need general understanding of how supply side alternatives work
- Board's powers related to a determination of disputes related to alternatives
- Requirements for Procedural Fairness in disputes between EGI and stakeholders over preferred option



MATTERS RELATED TO DETERMINATION OF NEED

- Appropriateness of discontinuing existing supply side IRPA contributing to justification of infrastructure
- If an IRPA is available then it ought to continue until evidence to the Board that the IRPA is not effective



MATTERS RELATED TO ALTERNATIVES

- Menu Identifies and Classifies Potential Alternatives
- Supply-Side, Market-based Solutions
 - ➤ Parkway Delivery Obligation (PDO) is a Best Practice Supply-side Alternative for EGI
 - > TCPL Long-term Transportation Service
- Pending Need for Solution



Menu - Identifies and Classifies Potential Alternatives

- Comprehensive Menu Provides Applicable Alternatives
- Categorization for Supply-side & Demand-side
- Identification of Bridging Solutions
- OEB Oversight Determines Additions or Deletions




Supply Side Market-Based Solutions

- Awareness of Supply-Side Solutions Essential
- EGI Evidenced Supply-side Alternatives
 - Peaking Supply
 - Delivered Supply
 - ➤ Exchange and Third-Party Assignments
 BUT DISMISSED as INAPPROPRIATE for Long Term
- Displacement different from Exchange



PARKWAY DELIVERY OBLIGATION






DISPLACEMENT CONCEPT

- Foundational to movement of gas in pipelines
- Particularly important inter-company pipeline inter-connections such as Parkway
- Harnessing Benefit of Existing Capability
- Provides for Integrated Gas Network Planning




TCPL – DAWN LTFP SERVICE

- Implemented in 2017
- Shippers signed Long Term Fixed Price (LTFP)
 contracts to transport gas from Alberta to Dawn
- Service provided enhanced flow into Ontario




TCPL MAINLINE PATHS TO ONTARIO

TCPL LTFP ARRANGEMENTS TO MEET PARKWAY/TORONTO DEMAND

- EGI solicits RFP for LTFP shippers commitment to deliver gas to TCPL each winter day for a multi-year period
- EGI contracts for the same level of reliability as other third party delivery agreements
- TCPL to schedule that gas to take the northern path to North Bay



BENEFITS OF SECURING EXISTING OPPORTUNITY

- Implementation of this initiative could create an timely bridging solution in support of other IRPA's with costs that are 10% of the annualized cost of a build
- Environmental and Societal Benefits in avoidance of installation of opposed pipeline with uncertain long term utilization
- Benefits could extend beyond the primary term
- Key Bridging Solution for Uncertain Times



MATTERS RELATED TO EVALUATION AND DETERMINATION OF ALTERNATIVES

- OEB Power to Determine Disputes Related to IRPA's
- Leaving EGI to Screen Appropriate Alternatives Leads to Frustration
- IRP Framework ought to Articulate the OEB's Power to Set the Schedule to Determine Disputes and Direct Implementation of the Most Effective Alternative



MATTERS RELATED TO EVALUATION AND DETERMINATION OF ALTERNATIVES

- IRP Framework ought to stress Procedural Fairness
- Allows Alternative Disputes to be Raised, Considered and Determined in a Timely Manner
- Phasing of Proceeding Affords Opportunity to Decide on Matters of Need and Alternatives in Advance of Implementation



MATTERS RELATED TO IMPLEMENTATION

- Activities Pursuing Innovative IRPA's may Require Oversight
- Opportunity to provide Nominal Incentive for Facilitating Solution but Not Return on Flow Through
- Monitoring and Reporting through Rate Case filings as Opposed to Stakeholder Sessions to Apply Rigour
