We are cottage owners on Big Hawk Lake in Algonquin Highlands. Our total cost of electricity after adjustments was \$650 for 2020. We are at the cottage approximately 7 weeks a year. Under proposed new costing, our annual electrical cost will be around \$1450. This is approaching the total cost for our permanent address. A stand alone "off grid " solar system would be approximately \$5500 installed, less than 4 year pay back. Pretty easy decision to offset the greed of Hydro One. Those are really expensive stainless steel, Yamaha powered boats that sit on our lakes to service customers. I won't be paying for that if this proposal goes through in the future.
