We have two properties in the City of Kawartha. We are retired and spend a fair amount of time at our properties year round. The elimination of The Seasonal Class, will increase our Hydro One bills substantially. There are more folks moving to our area due to Covid. There are a lot of permanent residents here now. We feel a good compromise, would be to move us all to R1 Medium density. This R1 Medium Density would benefit seniors on fixed incomes and younger families moving here.

If Hydro One rates increase, we may have to burn more wood, creating air pollution. Or use propane, fossil fuel, which the government is trying to reduce. We don't have the option of Natural gas at this time.

Therefore, the best resolution is to move the Seasonal Class to R1 Medium Density, to be fair for all.
