Our Hydro One Account Number which is for our cottage at Lake Talon, Olrig Township in the District of Nipissing. We reside there for 5 months a year and our average monthly electricity use for the last 12 months is 300.33 kwh. Using the table recently provided by Hydro One our electricity charges will increase by more than 54% using the monthly consumption of 350 kwh line in their table. This will increase our Hydro One bill by approximately \$300 per year and substantially more when the Ontario Electricity Rebate is abolished. Our total Hydro One bills for a 12 month period are now approximately \$1,100 for less than 5 months use.

Unfortunately for us the Hydro One service in our area is not the best and we suffer 3-5 electrical outages per year, sometimes several days in length. To increase our electrical bills when service is substandard compared to most other Ontario residents is patently unfair and this proposal by OEB needs to be rejected or substantially modified to better reflect the service we are receiving.
