**Re: EB-2020-0010 Chapleau Public Utilities Corporation - Application for 2021 Rates**

Jane Scott, the Ontario Energy Board's Manager of Major Rate Applications and Consolidations has been delegated authority under Section 6 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* to make a decision on the 2021 Price Cap IR application filed by Chapleau Public Utilities Corporation on November 2, 2020.
