We have just received the letter regarding the changes of classification for seasonal costumer will be moved to one of Hydro One Networks' other three residential rate classes.

According to your letter Hydro One Networks anticipates that we will move into the residential low density (R2) class. We understand that it will be a monhly bill with approximately an increase of \$60.00 per month. I have to disagree to this new expensive proposition because we go to our cottage for the most 3 to 5 days a week. Our first time would be the end of April or the beginning of May and soon after Thankgiving we close the place for the 6 months of the year.

That said I don't understand why the plan to charge seasonal cottagers for the full 12 months. We have had this property for 27 years and we are retirees with a limited retiree income, we feel that this move is going to make it impossible for us to upkeep this property. I hope you will reasses your changes and make things fair to people that do not use the property in winter and charge for the hydro as we were using it.
