According to the letter I received from Hydro One, my cottage property on Skin Lake, near Dorset ([REDACTED]) will move to Residential Low Density R2 Class resulting in a greater than 100% increase in my hydro charges. I am not objecting to the increase but I would like to note that the hydro service at my cottage goes out with great frequency. I certainly do hope that the increase that I will be paying will help to improve the reliability of the service I receive. If I am going to be paying considerably more, I expect that my hydro won't be interrupted dozens of times per season.

I do appreciate to text updates about power interruptions, but I hope to see far fewer of them in future.
