Re: A/C  Flie #EB-2020-0246 I have reviewed the notification letter dated Feb. 19, 2021 and, registered for e-mail updates and also called into the Customer Relations Centre to seek clarification of the potential impact to my Hydro Rate. With average monthly usage of 178.46kWh there is no way to plug this into your chart and get an accurate estimate of the impact to our monthly rate. I also do not know if this additional charge will be calculated on a monthly, quarterly or annual usage basis. Without proper notification of what is being proposed, it is impossible to provide a meaningful letter of objection (or support). Also, how do you determine what is "Residential Low Density" vs. "Residential Medium Density"? Depending on the definition I do not know if our seasonal residence has been properly classified. Too many unanswered questions. I look forward to learning more prior to any changes being arbitrarily implemented.
