This concerns our cottage property located in Timmins([REDACTED]). After receiving your notification of a change in our classification from Seasonal to Residential low density and coming to the conclusion that your rate change would mean a substantial increase to our hydro bill I have a few questions that I would need addressed. Our immediate area is made up of at least 25 lots of which 50% are permanent residences. We built our cottage in 2009 and have had an extra charge of \$111.00 on our quarterly invoice added in excess to delivery charge for actual electricity used. Upon speaking to neighbours who reside in the vicinity, it would appear that we the seasonal owners will be paying way more than them for the same service. Our quarterly bill ranges between \$250 and \$350 and so you see that we are not occasional users and this extra delivery charge is not warranted.

I believe that when it comes to delivery charge on actual usage we are also charged at a higher rate. If you can justify these discrepancies I would appreciate your comments.
