I am writing to express our concerns over the proposed rate increases for Hydro One seasonal cottage owners.

We are opposed to the choice of where you have placed us on the new classification of residential Low density R2.

Because "seasonal owners" are not consuming energy during the winter month, it doesn't seem justified, that our rates would be going up more than 50%, to pay Hydro during the few months we are at the cottage. We currently have a quarterly fee and when we are not even using the Hydro serves. Will you be removing the charges when we are not using hydro services?

There seems to be a large imbalance of rates, and I feel you are taking advantage of seasonal non-residents of Ontario.

There should be a standard rate for consumptions whether we are fulltime residences or not.

We are wanting to receiving future notification on EB-2020-0246.
