I'm writing to object to the ending of seasonal hydro and although I understand that is not up for review, I assume the increased rates are. I use electricity one month a year and already pay about \$500. To raise my rate 100% is unfair and punishes those in the less consumptive group. I would have to pay nearly \$1300 at the new rate, just for one month's low usage. Please do whatever you can to adjust this rate lower for the bottom tier of users. Also by using less electricity, we are supporting the environment. I don't want to be forced to using a generator instead of Hydro because of this skyrocketing new cost.
