Is there any consideration for these type of properties to be grandfathered into a continuing seasonal rate? Assuming not, my calculation from the letter received tells me that our monthly billing payment could increase from \$172.00 to \$291.00 which seems unreasonable particularly for retired pensioners etc. I am hoping my calculations are off target and also understand this may be the worst case scenario so will wait to see if further specific information is available. Not looking forward to any such increase when you compare our increased CPP and OAS totals approximately \$6.00 per month for both my wife and I.
