Good morning,

We own a seasonal property at [REDACTED] which has been in the family for 60 years.

We received a notice yesterday that Hydro One is proposing a substantial increase in rates that will negatively impact seasonal dwellers.

Our average monthly electricity use over the past 12 months is 40.77 kWh. Our usage is low because we can only access the property while the river is open.

It is a summer cottage and occupancy during the winter months is not an option.

According to the table included in the letter the proposed change in category (moving from Seasonal to Residential Low Density (R2) Class) would more than double the amount we are presently paying.

We think that such an increase is excessive and needs to be reviewed.
