Dear Sir/Madam

Respectfully, the Community on Wiley Lake in the Minden Hills Township is requesting that Hydro One give consideration to reclassifying the sixteen accounts surrounding our small lake from Residential Low Density (R2) to Residential Medium Density (R1).

We are making this request based on the length of the line that starts in Irondale and includes our dwellings on Wiley Lake Lane, Nodin Drive and Cannonball Lane. Given the number of Hydro One accounts along this line, including those along the shores of Salerno Lake, we are led to believe that our Lake meets the spirit of Hydro One's classification system in that we meet the Residential Medium Density ((R1) classification parameter of 15 accounts per KM of line and at least 100 accounts in total.

A re-assignment of the proposed classification from Low Density(R2) to the classification of Medium Density (R1) for our Lake community will be greatly appreciated.
