We are already paying what I consider high hydro rates From Aug 25,2020 to Feb 24,2021 I have paid to Ontario Hydro 1076.54. When is enough - enough for the supply of power. My wife and I are retired and love the cottage, is it the OEB's intention to make owning a vacation property out of reach for retired people, who live on a fixed income. If Hydro Rates go up 54 per cent this puts a strain on ALL those families, especially during the last year.
