Talking to a Hydro One representative it seems like the elimination of the seasonal rate class will increase our monthly rate by at least 30%. This seems quite an excessively large increase so of course we're not in favour of this change.

Our cottage is locating around a farming community. This make the surrounding properties quite spread out so I expect we fall into the low density rate.  
But we're just 1 pole to the cottage from the main highway so it's not a inconvenient or isolated location. We only use hydro during the 4 summer months so there wouldn't be a need of it in the wintertime. The main portion of the bill is the delivery cost and not the usage as it's under 50 kWh.

We'd like you to reconsider the decision.
