We have been seasonal cottage owners for 30yrs retired on a fixed income for 16yrs. Between 1991-2004 aver. cottage use was 2-3wks yearly; 2004 to present aver. use 4-6wk. Even though our cottage was closed 7to8 months per year we sill received hydro bills.

The "table/formula" is nothing more than an excuse to justify increasing revenue on the backs of seasonal cottage owners.

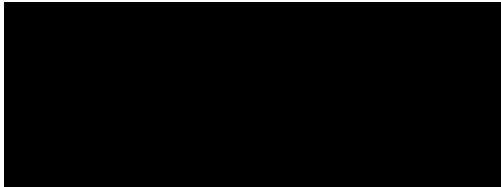
