I have reviewed the notice Hydro One has sent out to seasonal properties.
The category of **Seasonal Property is to be eliminated.**
It is advising that a proposed increases might become effective **January 1, 2022** or later.

Changes to R2 Class bill due to the elimination of the seasonal category will increase our yearly billing in excess of \$ 600.00.
We already pay more for our seasonal use (6 months / year) cottage than our yearly Manitoba Hydro bill for our home in Winnipeg.
Now we have to pay an additional in excess of \$600.00 per year.
This is completely unacceptable.
Hydro One should look to greater efficiency not ridiculous increases to customers
Many of us are retired seniors with a limited fixed income.
For some it may be out of reach.
Hydro One should re-evaluate this proposal.
