We have had a family cottage on Golden Lake since 1972. We have always found the delivery charges for electricity high. This is what we paid in the past two years

2020: Electricity \$561.27; Delivery \$967.89; (ratio 1.7)

2019: Electricity \$233.86; Delivery \$724.10; (ratio 3.1)

We have been informed that we are going to be moved to the R2 Class which will increase our delivery costs by about \$55 per month or \$660 annually.

This is ridiculous.

We do not fully understand the reasoning behind this decision.

We ask that in the upcoming public hearing that you make best efforts to minimize these cost increases. These increases make it increasingly difficult to maintain ownership of the property.
