On January 28, 2021, the OEB issued its Decision and Order for the above noted proceeding which included, as Schedule B, several Conditions of Approval.

Per section 3 of the Conditions of Approval, Enbridge Gas shall file with the OEB, prior to the commencement of construction, a letter of opinion from the Ministry of Energy, Northern Development and Mines (MENDM) stating that MENDM is satisfied with the adequacy of procedural aspects of the Indigenous consultation for the Project. Enbridge Gas is therefore advising the OEB that on March 26, 2021, it has received the letter of opinion from the MENDM indicating that the procedural aspects of consultation undertaken by Enbridge Gas to date for the purposes of the OEB's Leave to Construct for the London Lines Replacement Project is satisfactory.
