I am writing with regards to the changes that Hydro One proposes in EB-2020-0246. They say that half the customers will see a rate increase and half will see a rate decrease. For example, using 350kWh, one half will see a rate decrease of -5% and -25%, an average of 15% . Therefore, other half should see a rate increase of 15% but an increase of 54% is proposed.
