**DECISION AND ORDER**

Oneida Energy Storage LP (Oneida) filed an application on February 3, 2021 under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) for an electricity storage licence.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority, pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

Oneida is a joint venture between NRStor Inc., a Toronto based energy storage development company, and Six Nations of the Grand River Development Corporation. Oneida is a special purpose entity formed in November 2019 to develop, own and operate a 250 MW battery storage facility in Southwestern Ontario. The facility is expected to be operational in January 2022.

After considering the application and assessing technical capability and financial viability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue the electricity storage licence to Oneida Energy Storage LP.

1. The application is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
