**Re: Demand Power Group Inc.
Application for Electricity Generation Licence
OEB File Number EB-2021-0101**

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) received Demand Power Group Inc.'s (Demand Power) application for an electricity generation licence on March 17, 2021. The OEB has assigned file number EB-2021-0101 to the application. The application will be decided by an employee of the OEB who has been delegated this authority pursuant to section 6 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (Delegated Authority). The Delegated Authority intends to make a decision on the application without holding a hearing.

The OEB has preliminary reviewed your application. Your application is currently incomplete and cannot be processed until the following has been filed:

1. Section 8, Page 5: Intended Services and Markets

Demand Power answered "No" to the question 8 (c) asking whether a person it intends to sell electricity to is a consumer. Please explain your answer and power selling arrangements.

2. Section 10, Page 6: Facility History and Status

This section requires the applicant to provide information on all other regulatory approvals required and identify status of each approval. No information on other regulatory approvals has been provided by Demand Power. Please provide the required information.

3. Section 11, Page 7: Connection

Please provide a diagram demonstrating all components of the generation facility, distribution assets to connect to the customer's facility and the connection point to the customer's facility. Please identify the ownership of all components included in the diagram, i.e. if the components are owned by the applicant or the customer.

4. Section 13: Finance and Section 16: Key Individual Information

Demand Power has not provided any financial information in support of the application, nor it has provided information on each key individual listed in section 7.

Although the OEB acknowledges that Demand Power has recently filed several applications with the OEB, for the record keeping purposes, it is not allowed to omit information required in the application form even if it has been filed before as part of another application. Please file financial information required in section 13 as well as completed section 16 for each key individual identified in section 7 of the application form.

The OEB will resume processing your application once the above information has been filed. If the above information is not filed within 30 days of the date of this letter, the OEB may close the file for this application.

Once your application is complete, the Delegated Authority expects to issue a final decision on your application within 60-90 days.

In the event the Delegated Authority decides to deny or otherwise modify the relief you requested in your application, you will be given an opportunity to provide comments. The Delegated Authority will consider your final comments, if any, prior to issuing a decision and order.
