Thank you for the opportunity to respond.

I am disappointed with the OEB decision to eliminate the Hydro One Seasonal Rate classification. As a seasonal user, my electricity consumption is low, and consequently the unit cost is quite high. For the two-year period 2019 and 2020, the effective cost for my property has been \$1.06 per kilowatt-hour. According to the notice from Hydro One, this is expected to double upon being moved to the R2 class. I consider this to be an unjustified and exorbitant cost.
