Dear OEB,

We are writing to express our grave concern over the proposed changes to our hydro classification at the cottage.

The proposed increase is astronomically high and unfairly distributed. While we are expected to pay an increase of **76%** in our fees those in the Low Density, Medium, Density and High Density Classes can expect a sizable discount.

We have always paid the delivery charge and will continue to do so, as well as pay for our actual consumption. Why should we be charged a much larger amount for our consumption compared to those in other classes.

Is the intention of the OEB to drive cottagers out of Ontario?

We wish to be kept informed of the proceedings and by writing this letter meet the deadline stated in your letter received just a short time ago. I was informed during a lengthy phone conversation with Maloney from the OEB that the deadline would in fact be extended.
