The plan to move seasonal customers of Hydro One Network to Residential Low Density class and charge an atrocious 100% increase is criminal. You are actually charging those who use the least power the highest price. How does this increase to the seasonal class compare to what farmers are charged. My family only uses our cottage for four months of the year.
