**Re: Halton Hills Hydro Inc. 2021 Cost of Service Rate Application,
Response to Intervenor Cost Claims
Board No.: EB-2020-0026**

On August 27, 2020, Halton Hills Hydro Inc. filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (“OEB” or the “Board”) under Section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* as amended and pursuant to the OEB’s *Filing Requirements for Incentive Rate-setting Applications* seeking approval for electricity distribution rates, and other charges, effective May 1, 2021.

The Board issued a Decision and Order in this matter on March 18, 2021. The Board directed Halton Hills Hydro Inc. to file a Draft Rate Order by March 25, 2021, that incorporates the OEB’s determinations in its Decision and Order. The Draft Rate Order was filed accordingly.

Intervenors and OEB Staff submitted comments related to the Draft Rate Order between April 1, 2021 and April 5, 2021 as provided for in the Decision and Order. In response to the comments, Halton Hills Hydro Inc. filed an updated Tariff Schedule and Bill Impact Model.

Additionally, as per the Board issued a Decision and Order in this matter on March 18, 2021, intervenors were to submit cost claims to the Board and copy Halton Hills Hydro Inc. Halton Hills Hydro Inc. received cost claims from:

- School Energy Coalition \$ 27,393.46
- Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition \$ 31,727.69
- Energy Prove Research Foundation \$ 13,360.43
- Distributed Resource Coalition \$ 9,641.16

Halton Hills Hydro Inc. has no issue with the cost claims submitted.
