I completely understand that people in Ontario might find that the seasonal customer rates create a disproportionate power system maintenance burden for other Ontarians. If political liberals are correct, then there will be an increase in power customers providing power to the grid or (problematically) dropping out of the grid in favor of stored electrical energy from renewable sources. As this would also tend to re-shift grid maintenance to other Ontarians, and since the power grid is a de-facto disaster management system, I think it needs to be maintained. I therefore suggest that the cost of the grid be based on the value of improvements to a property in something like an assessed tax.
