**Re: EB-2021-0126
ENWIN Utilities Ltd. - Distribution System Code Section 5.1.3 (b) Exemption
Confirmation of Compliance**

On March 26, 2021, ENWIN Utilities Ltd. ("ENWIN") filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board ("OEB") requesting an extension of the temporary exemption from section 5.1.3 (b) of the Distribution System Code ("DSC") from March 31, 2021 to April 30, 2021. ENWIN stated that despite the ongoing challenges related to the COVID-19 pandemic, it had completed the required MIST meter installations with the exception of one active GS>50 account, where the customer had to complete repairs before ENWIN could safely replace the meter.

On March 31, 2021, through its EB-2021-0126 Decision and Order, the OEB granted the extension until April 30, 2021.

ENWIN is writing to inform the OEB that it has completed the above-noted meter exchange for the last remaining GS>50 account and has now satisfied the requirements of section 5.1.3 (b) of the DSC.
