Imperial Oil Limited (Imperial Oil) filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on February 23, 2021 under section 99 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B), seeking approval to expropriate certain lands rights along the route of the OEB-approved Waterdown to Finch Project (Application).

On April 19, 2021 Imperial Oil filed a letter with the OEB requesting to withdraw the portions of its application to expropriate certain land rights owned by the City of Mississauga described in Appendix D-1 and by the Canadian Pacific Railway Company described in Appendix D-4 to the Application. Imperial Oil advised that it wishes to withdraw these portions of the Application because resolutions have been reached with the City of Mississauga and the Canadian Pacific Railway Company.

The OEB accepts Imperial Oil's request to withdraw the portions of the Application related to the interests in the lands owned by the City of Mississauga and the Canadian Pacific Railway Company. The procedural schedule set in the Procedural Order No. 1 remains in effect.
