Re: Re: EB-2021-0076 Consultation to Update Filing Requirements Request to Participate and seek cost recovery by the Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition (VECC)

In its letter of April 15, 2021 the OEB sought interest to participate in a working to review filing requirements for small utilities for 2023 rates.
